The PGS makes it possible for givers to:

- Give One-Off amounts by Credit/Debit
cards and Apple/Google pay wallets.
- Give monthly, quarterly, or annually by
Direct Debit.
- Sign up to inflation-linked giving
annually.
- Enhance your gift to your church by
having Gift Aid at 25% added to your
giving.
- Give anonymously.
- The system is secure, confidential, and
easy to use.
