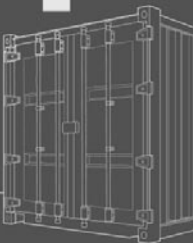

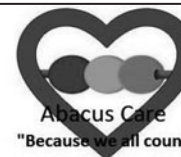

## A LETTER FROM OUR CHURCHWARDENS

In the Christian Church our focus in December is Advent. It's the beginning of a new church year and a season of expectation and preparation, as we prepare to celebrate the birth (adventus) of Christ.



We recognise that the commercial pressures around Christmas have made it harder to sustain a sense of watchfulness and hopefulness, but the key Advent prayer remains 'Maranatha' – 'Our Lord, come'. Church decorations are simple (no flowers, just 'the holly and the ivy'). In the northern hemisphere, the Advent season falls at the darkest time of the year, and the natural symbols of darkness and light are powerfully at work throughout Advent and Christmas. We will light candles on an Advent wreath, a tradition that was imported into Britain from northern Europe in the nineteenth century. The Third Sunday of Advent was observed in medieval times as Gaudete or 'Rose Sunday', and this provides a splash of colour in the restrained atmosphere of Advent.

In Milborne Port, we will celebrate the lighting of the village lights right at the end of November, and then the village Christmas Tree Festival will be held in St John's Church from 7th to 14th December, so the church will have a week of light and beauty in Advent. The children at the primary school will have their own Christingle celebration in school and then they will come to the church a week later for their Carol Service.

Christmas time can be an extremely difficult time for so many however, with the twinkling lights and endless Christmas songs and carols being played in shops and over the airwaves. This jollity only accentuates the

pain which many feel in their hearts at this time of year, so we commend the **Longest Night Service on Saturday 21st December at 3 p.m.** It is a gentler, reflective service of carols and readings, with the recognition that those present may very well find Christmas challenging.

We must acknowledge that the Church of England has been rocked by the resignation of Archbishop Welby following the publication of the Makin Report, which exposed the heinous acts committed by John Smyth and the failure of many who chose not to follow up the allegations against him. We at St John's take Safeguarding very seriously and have robust policies and procedures in place. Safeguarding, actively taking care of each other, is the responsibility of all of us.



Finally, as December begins, we are very happy to be welcoming back Rev. Rona from her sabbatical. We would like to thank all those who have helped cover Rona's absence in the past three months, particularly our retired clergy, Brian McConnell, Stuart Thomas, Diane Barrett, Frank Wright and Jane Craw.

Wishing you a peaceful Advent and a joyous Christmas.

From 1<sup>st</sup> December we start predominantly using Luke's Gospel for the Sunday readings. Luke has 24 chapters. So, for the month of December, as we wait for the celebration of the coming of Christ on the 25<sup>th</sup>, join me in reading a chapter of Luke's Gospel each day.



There will be two opportunities each week to meet and reflect on the meaning of Advent, Luke's Gospel and the appointed Sunday Gospel texts. The first will be on a Wednesday, and the second on a Saturday. All meetings will take place in Milborne Port.

Wednesday 4<sup>th</sup>, 11<sup>th</sup> and 18<sup>th</sup> December / Saturday 7<sup>th</sup>, 14<sup>th</sup> December.

**Wednesday** Meet in the Lady Chapel of St John's at 11.00 a.m. , or preferably come to half hour Communion first at 10.30, and stay on for 45 minutes of Advent Reflections. This will include music, poetry, silence and discussion on the chapters which we have read of Luke's Gospel thus far.

**Saturday** Come along to the church 10 a.m. -11 a.m. for more Advent Reflections with music, poetry, silence and discussion on the Bible Reading which we will hear on the next day. (7<sup>th</sup> Dec - Luke 3:1-6, 14<sup>th</sup> Dec - Luke 3:7-18)

## Milborne Port Christmas Tree Festival

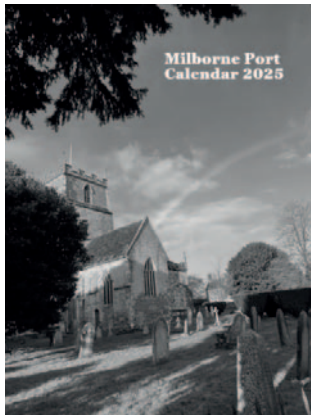
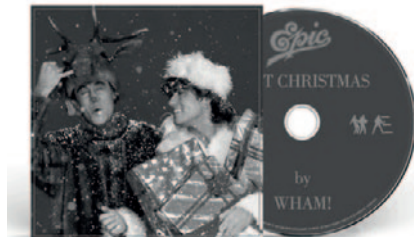

## Remembering



*This is an occasional series, commemorating each of the 19 Milborne Port men who died in service during the Second World War, on the 80th anniversary of his death. It reflects the wartime losses in real time but 80 years on. Our thanks to Naomi Thorp for her work on this.*

### Thomas Newman died December 1944

Thomas Newman was a Sergeant in the Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve with 460 Squadron Bomber Command when he was killed in a raid over Germany on 24<sup>th</sup> December 1944. He and his fellow crew members were buried in a collective grave at Oostelbeers Roman Catholic Cemetery, Holland, on 27<sup>th</sup> December 1944, after a service led by the Canadian chaplain who had witnessed the crash.

George Abram and Maud Edith Newman, his parents, lived at Crackmore Lodge in Milborne Port and Thomas was the fifth of their six children. In January 1941 he married Doreen Amy Garrett and the Parish Magazine shows that their daughter, Diane Myra, was christened at St John's Church in November 1942. They also had a son, David, who was born in November 1943.

## Pause for Thought

Living alongside the busy A30, as I do, I rarely experience time without the incessant noise of traffic. When I can get away – and it need not be far from Milborne Port – I can walk in the woods and find a little peace.

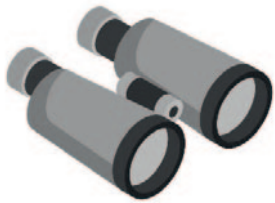
Silence in our busy, noisy world is a rare commodity. Very occasionally, as on Remembrance Sunday, we have a communal silence shared across the whole country. Some people seem to be afraid of silence, filling any quietness with radio, music or television or with chatter. Silence can leave us alone with our thoughts, in an empty space, which can be invaded by our anxious, fearful internal soundtrack.

But for others, silence brings relief, a reduction in stress and anxiety, a time to allow the mind to drift and dream as our thoughts settle into the quietness. Silence can bring healing and restoration of the mind. Physiologists tell us about the benefits of relaxation and of cultivating silence, from reduced blood pressure, lowered stress hormone cortisol, better and more restful sleep. The aim of meditation is not to empty the mind but rather to train the mind to focus on the present moment

In recent years, there has been a renewal of interest both in silent prayer and in mindfulness and meditation. These have always been a feature of Eastern religions and is central to Buddhism, but a contemplative life is a core and fundamental part of Christianity and has been for nearly two thousand years in monastic communities. Many churches in the Middle Ages housed hermits – anchorites and anchoresses - seeking a quiet solitary life of contemplation. One such person was the 14<sup>th</sup> century anchoress Julian of Norwich.

In Sherborne, there are two groups practicing silence together:- Sherborne Quakers who meet in the Digby Memorial Hall, in Digby St at 10:30 every Sunday, and the Julian Meetings in Sherborne Abbey at 4 p.m. Second Wednesday in the month. *Margaret Capon*

## Bird Therapy



Since I wrote my first birding article for the magazine a year ago, my passion for bird watching has strengthened. At that time I had recorded 107 UK species. These numbers have risen to 257 globally of which 140 are UK bird species. I have graduated to a slightly better camera, a lighter pair of binoculars and several more second hand bird identification books.

Any hobby which brings you closer to nature is something I would definitely recommend. When you are out walking, occasionally stopping to observe the birds you hear and see, the stresses of everyday life literally disappear and you become consumed with the immense beauty of it all.


But you don't even need to leave your house. If you have a garden, no matter how big or small, you can attract a large number of bird species to bird feeders here in Milborne Port. I have recorded Blue Tits, Coal Tits, Great Tits, Long-tailed Tits, Goldfinches, Chaffinches, Green Finch, Black Caps, House Sparrows, Blackbirds, Robins, Nuthatch (photo), Starlings, Magpie and Great Spotted Woodpecker and there is always a Dunnock or a Pigeon or two, on the ground clearing up the scraps!

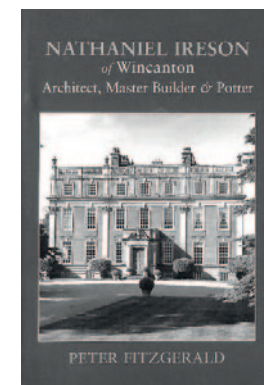

## Milborne Port History & Heritage Group

Members of Henstridge U3A were our guests on 8<sup>th</sup> November for a guided walk around the ancient borough and a visit to the Museum (after lunch at The Tippi!) We received some great feedback and hope to see some of them again at the Museum in the Summer.

For our talk on Monday 18<sup>th</sup> November, we were joined by Peter and Sarah Fitzgerald to tell us about the life and works of Nathaniel Ireson of Wincanton (1685-1769), the builder of Ven House in the time of James Medlycott, and about Ireson's delft pottery factory; Peter is the author of *Nathaniel Ireson: Architect, Master Builder & Potter*. Peter showed us many examples of Ireson's architectural skills, and Sarah gave us a charming whistle-stop tour through the Wincanton pottery works.



At the end of the talk, we revealed that the sixth great-granddaughter of Nathaniel Ireson – who by happy coincidence lives in Milborne Port – had been sitting in the audience all along! And as if wasn't wonderful enough, we then discovered that there was yet another Ireson descendant amongst us! A delightful family reunion followed, as you can imagine...

There will be no talk this month, but our first talk of 2025 on Monday 20<sup>th</sup> January will be given by members of the Committee and will take you on a tour around some interesting buildings of historical import in the village, including Bazzleways and Manor Farm House. More details in the January magazine.

## The December Night Sky

*This Advent moon shines cold and clear,  
These Advent nights are long:  
Our lamps have burned year after year,  
And still their flame is strong.*

*Christina Rossetti, from "Advent"*

This month we will be blessed with both Jupiter and Venus at their most spectacular for 2024. Venus will be dominant in the west and Jupiter high in the south. Not to be outdone Mars also burns bright. Add in the constellations Orion, Canis Major, Canis Minor, Taurus and Gemini and you have the most perfect backdrop for anyone watching the night sky this December.

1<sup>st</sup>: Start of meteorological winter, First Sunday in Advent and New Moon

4<sup>th</sup>: Early evening view of Venus and the crescent moon together low in the southwest sky.

7<sup>th</sup>: Jupiter bright all night.

8<sup>th</sup>: rising together at dusk there will be a close approach of Saturn and the moon. First quarter moon.

9<sup>th</sup>: Close approach of the Moon and Venus. Both rise in the East at about 4:20 am and are lost in the dawn by 7:20 am.



13<sup>th</sup> – 14<sup>th</sup>: Geminids meteor shower, interference from moonlight - so poor viewing this year with only the brightest trails visible.

15<sup>th</sup>: Full Moon: the full moon this year falls before midwinter, so it is known as the Moon before Yule.

14<sup>th</sup>-17<sup>th</sup>: Close approach of the moon and Mars, rising together at dusk and then on subsequent nights a little late until by the 17<sup>th</sup> they will rise together at about 7 p.m..

**21<sup>st</sup>: Winter Solstice**, the Sun is at its lowest point in the sky. On this day we will have our shortest day and longest night. Also, the start of astronomical winter. - from this point forward, the days gradually grow longer until we reach the summer solstice. The lighting of bonfires at this time of year traditionally represents the slow return of the light.

22<sup>nd</sup>: Last quarter moon.

30<sup>th</sup>: New moon – and it's a blue moon. A 'blue moon' is the second full moon in a calendar month with two full moons, it is a relatively rare occurrence, hence the expression "once in a blue moon".



## Sunrise and Sunset

1<sup>st</sup>: Sunrise 7:51 a.m. Sunset: 4:09 p.m.

31<sup>st</sup>: Sunrise 8:14 a.m. Sunset: 4:14 p.m.

In Milborne Port, the first day of the month is 08 hours, 18 minutes long. The last day of December is 08 hours, so the length of the days gets 18 minutes shorter in December 2024.

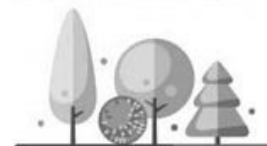
